KUAS has agreements and international exchange programs with universities in the United States, South Korea, Taiwan, Mongol, Thailand, China, and Indonesia.

***Note: In the "Overseas Travel Safety Information" published by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, if the Travel advice and Warning level is 2 or higher, students will not be able to go abroad as an exchange student even if they have passed the selection process. The university will make a decision as to whether students will be permitted to study abroad or not approximately two months before departure.**

Criteria for Applying to the Study Abroad Program

<For students enrolled before AY 2020>

- Students must have been enrolled in KUAS for at least 1 year at the time of their departure for student exchange.
- Students must satisfy the standards specified by the partner university to which students are applying.
- At the time of the application, the student must have attained an average of at least 18 credits per semester.
- At the time of application, the student must hold a GPA of at least 2.0.

<For Students enrolled after AY 2021>

- Students must have been enrolled in KUAS for at least 1 year at the time of their departure for student exchange.
- Students must satisfy the standards specified by the partner university to which students are applying.
- At the time of the application, the student must have attained an average of at least 20 credits per semester. (*1)
 - *1: Approved Courses (which have no effect on GPA) and year-long courses that do not release grades in the Spring semester shall be counted as acquired credit for one semester.
- At the time of the application, the student must have completed all required courses up to the previous semester.
- At the time of application, the student must hold a GPA of at least 2.0.
